## Introducing the 'British Islamic Medical Association (BIMA)'

Dear Doctor, Assalaam Alaikum wa Rahmatullahi wa Barakatuhu! By the Grace of Allah SWT, work has begun to found a British Islamic Medical Association (BIMA) with the following objectives:

- 1. To promote better understanding and appreciation of principles and values of Islam amongst all health care professionals.
- 2. To protect and promote the health of patients and the public by adhering to fundamentals of Islamic ethics and good medical practice.
- 3. To encourage professional and social interaction among Muslim health care professionals and with wider medical community in the UK
- 4. To promote research and education in the field of medicine, Islamic medical history and Islamic medical ethics.
- 5. To engage our professional skills in charitable activities locally and globally to help the needy irrespective of colour, creed or faith.
- 6. To advise & support Muslim health care professionals and students in career development, orientation and other work related issues. This will be an independent, not-for-profit, democratic organisation of Muslim health care professionals in the UK. Our mission statement/aim: "To seek the pleasure of Allah Almighty through character building, professional development and service to mankind, in accordance with the teachings of Allah (SWT) and His last messenger Muhammad (peace be upon him)" To make this organisation a success inshaAllah, a wide-ranging consultation has been held over the past year. Advice and support was sought and received from eminent Muslim medical professionals, and different stakeholders, leaders and opinion makers across the length and breadth of Muslim communities in UK and across the world. In December 2012, a group of 25 doctors from all over the country subsequently met in Leicester to discuss the concept of organising Muslim doctors in the UK.
